then we have to focus on the education of women as well because they are also essential for contributing to the economy. If there will be gender equality in the nation then the economy of that country will be highly stable.

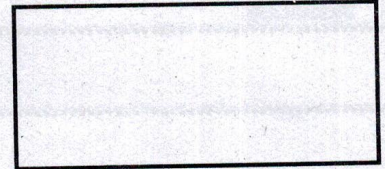
DEFENCE:-
