Fell in love of Desire:

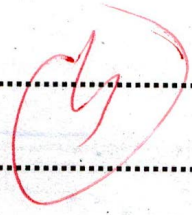
Desire was a beautiful girl and Armand fell in love with her. A Desire was orphan and was grown up by a nomade but her background doesn't matter for Armand and married her.

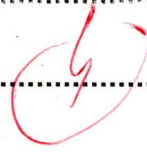
The Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) equated himself with the Last brick of a beautiful house in the following hadith;
