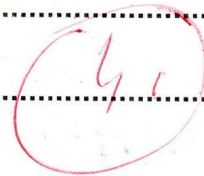

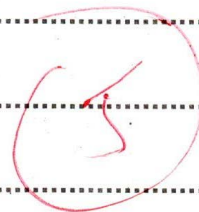

Quaid-e-Azam said that the people would be free to go to their temples, mosques or any other place of worship in Pakistan.

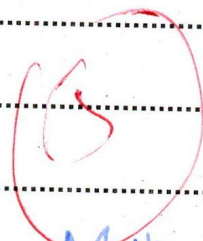

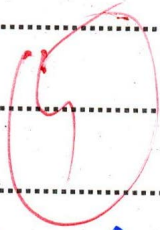
Hazrat Muhammad
